

Notice of Public Meetings HSEM Region 3 Emergency Managers Joint Powers Board

Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 13D, notice is hereby given to members of the HSEM Region 3 Emergency Managers Joint Powers Board and the general public that the Board will hold multiple meetings that are open to the public throughout the calendar year. Four meetings will be held in person, and the rest are held via telephone conference call. **Meetings always occur the 4th Thursday of every month unless otherwise posted.** The Board reserves the right to cancel or reschedule meetings at their discretion.

The Board retains the right to take agenda items out of order as needed for quorum or other purposes. Agenda items with presentations are noted. Staff is available to clarify or address any related comments.
