This agreement provides for adequate maintenance of a holding tank per Article V, Section 2.04 of the Hubbard County Subsurface Sewage Treatment System ordinance. We, the undersigned parties, hereby agree to the following terms:

The tank shall use an alarm to be set at 25% reserve capacity and shall be pumped when 75% capacity is reached; or once per year on or before October 31st of every year unless high groundwater conditions are problematic; OR when required by Hubbard County Environmental Services.

It shall be the responsibility of the property owner to contact the licensed SSTS maintainer when the alarm indicates 75% tank capacity has been reached.

It shall be the responsibility of the licensed SSTS maintainer to certify each date the tank is pumped, the volume of liquid waste removed, the treatment site to or site on which the waste was discharged, and the water meter reading at the time of pumping and report all this information to the Environmental Services Department at least once per calendar year. Failure to submit said pumping evidence may be grounds for Hubbard County to require removal of the holding tank.

If nuisance conditions develop or any ground surfacing is observed, tank removal may be required. Any other conditions attached to approval of the holding tank permit shall also be adhered to or tank removal may be required.

This agreement shall remain in effect until the Environmental Services Department receives written notice from the property owner that the owner executed a new Septage Hauling Contract with a different SSTS maintainer or written notice from the SSTS maintainer that the maintainer is cancelling its servicing of this holding tank. If the latter occurs, septage cannot be deposited into the holding tank until the property owner files with the Environmental Services Department a new signed contract with another licensed SSTS maintainer.
