SUNDAY LIQUOR ORDINANCE NUMBER 24

AN ORDINANCE PERMITTING THE SALE OF INTOXICATING LIQUOR ON SUNDAYS IN THE COUNTY OF HUBBARD SUBJECT TO APPLICABLE STATUTES AND APPROPRIATE LICENSES AND PERMITS

Be it ordained and enacted by the County Board of Commissioners of the County of Hubbard, State of Minnesota, as follows:

WHEREAS, Minnesota Statutes §340A.504, Subd.3, authorizes a county after one public hearing, by ordinance, to permit a restaurant, hotel, bowling center, or club to sell intoxicating liquor for consumption on the premises in conjunction with the sale of food between the hours of 10:00 a.m. on Sundays and 1:00a.m. on Mondays, provided that the licensee is in conformance with the Minnesota Clean Air Act, and provide further that it is authorized to do so by the voters of the town that contains the licensed premises by a vote on the day of the annual election of town officers, and

WHEREAS, a public hearing has been held this 6th day of April, 1994, pursuant to published notice as provided by law, now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, by the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Hubbard, State of Minnesota, on this 6th day of April, A.D. 1994, that the sale of intoxicating liquor be allowed on Sundays in the County of Hubbard conditioned upon the possession of a valid license therefor and pursuant to applicable statutes.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its approval, passage, and publication as provided by law.
