

## **Licensing**

### **Child Care Licensing**

The ChildCare Licensing program provides assistance to Hubbard County residents 18 years of age and older wishing to become licensed to provide child care in their home. The licensing process includes fire and safety inspections of the home, a criminal background study, and the discussion of State licensing guidelines and standards.

### **Child Foster Care Licensing**

Foster parents provide a stable and loving home for children who are in need of temporary care. The licensing social worker assists the prospective foster parents by coordinating the licensing process, which includes a criminal background study, home safety and fire checks, and letters of reference.

### **Adult Foster Care Licensing**

Hubbard County Social Services assists clients who wish to provide Foster Care services to adults in the community. A licensing social worker provides coordination services to prospective Foster Caregivers. The licensing process includes a criminal background study, home safety and fire checks, and letters of reference.

### **Adoption Services**

Hubbard County Social Services provides adoptive placement services to children who are in need of adoptive homes through the use of the State Adoption Exchange.
